

Proposed Local Law _____ 2006

A local law establishing qualifications for electrical inspectors

1. Section 4 – Electrical Inspector of local law No. 3 of the year 1981 – the Electrical Code of the Town of Dryden – is hereby amended by labeling the existing paragraph as (A) and by adding new subparagraphs (B) and (C) to read as follows:

(B) A qualified Electrical Inspector means a person who:

- (1) Has passed the New York State Civil Service Examination and is currently eligible for appointment as an electrical inspector according to the rules of the Civil Service Commission, or
- (2) Has been certified as a Residential Electrical Inspector (for single or two family residential home construction) by the International Association of Electrical Inspectors, or
- (3) Has been certified as a Master Electrical Inspector for all other types of construction by the International Association of Electrical Inspectors, or
- (4) Has been recognized as a journeyman electrician by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers for a period of at least five years.

(C) A person not meeting the qualifications of subparagraph (B) above may petition the town board for appointment as an Electrical Inspector by reason of his education, training, work experience or employment as an electrician, or as an electrical inspector.

2. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
